

GCC King II Coal Mine Timeline

- August 2004 GCC King II obtains coal and surface lease from BLM (Bureau of Land Management), DRMS (Division of Reclamation Mining and Safety) permit issued
- August 29, 2006 determination letter by Planning Director of no jurisdiction
- July 2007 King II Mine operations commence
- August 2010 County Attorney notifies GCC land use permit is in fact required
- July 11, 2012 GCC submits land use permit (Class II 2012-0089), public notice sent
- Agency comments sent and Staff review begins
- September 11, 2012 Neighborhood Compatibility Meeting #1, public notice sent
- Fall 2013 Analytical Activities Study completed
- December 19, 2013 Neighborhood Compatibility Meeting #2, public notice sent
- April 2014 Neighborhood Compatibility Meeting #3 (re: truck parking), public notice sent
- May 2014 Analytical Activities Study updated
- November 13, 2014 Planning Commission hearing, public notice sent – Continued, no discussion
- December 11, 2014 Planning Commission hearing, public notice sent – Continued, no discussion
- December 18, 2014 GCC hosts neighborhood meeting #4 – no formal notice
- January 23, 2015 County Staff conducts inter-jurisdictional meeting with BLM & DRMS, with Office of Surface Mining (OSM) on the phone
- January 27, 2015 GCC hosts neighborhood meeting #5 – notice sent by SWLS (Southwest Land Services)
- February – Staff continues to meeting with neighbors and GCC to discuss project
- March – GCC forms Citizen Advisory Panel to inform revised submittal to the County
- April 8, 2015 County notifies GCC of actions to be incorporated into an Interim Measures
- April 20, 2015 County hosts second inter-jurisdictional meeting with BLM & DRMS, with Office of Surface Mining (OSM)
- June 17, 2015 – County receives GCC's interim letter response, timeline proposed
- April 23, 2015 – County meeting with GCC regarding their response to County's April Interim Measures letter
- June 18, 2015 – Hay Gulch Citizen Advisory Panel hosts community meeting (public meeting #6) to discuss recommendations (extensive notice sent by HGCAP with GCC assistance)
- July 31, 2015 - GCC submits revised CLII application and new Variance application
- August 26, 2015 – GCC submits additional information for CLII application
- TBD - Neighborhood Compatibility Meeting (TBD)
- TBD - Staff analysis to determine project compliance
- TBD – Board of Adjustments hearing for Variance request
- TBD - Planning Commission hearing for Class II Land Use Permit
- TBD - Board of County Commissioners hearing for Class II Land Use Permit
- TBD - Compliance with conditions, site inspection, etc.
